NALMS believes that recognizing exceptional work accomplished by students is vital to the future of lake management science. NALMS therefore encourages students to present papers and posters at the NALMS 29<sup>th</sup> International Symposium in Hartford, Connecticut, October 27-31, 2009.

NALMS' Annual International Symposium affords a prime opportunity to evaluate and give awards to students for exceptional work. Two awards are presented each year: Best Student Paper and Best Student Poster. Honorable mentions are also awarded in the Student Paper and Student Poster categories.

The students who win the Student Paper and Student Poster awards each receive a \$200 cash award and a plaque commemorating the award. The students who are awarded an honorable mention in each category receive a free one year student membership in NALMS and a plaque.

The awards and award recipients are published in the next issue of LakeLine following the Symposium.

The NALMS Student Awards Committee evaluates the student paper presentations and student posters using the following criteria: originality, scientific merit, research design, and clarity of presentation.
